






Where is EMET college?



EMET Mission & Vision

- **Building for the future of ministry**
- **MISSION:** Preparing Bible workers for evangelism and training young people to become medical missionaries
- **VISION:** Multiplying leaders who will impact communities in Thailand and possibly worldwide
- EMET delivers 2-year **Evangelism** and **Medical missionary** training programs to support outreach ministries



Who are the students?

- 40% of students come from unreached remote war zones
- 60% of students come from the Thai-Burma border and nearby refugee camps
- Students who enrol are typically 17 yrs old+ who have been orphaned or displaced



A Classroom for the Great Commission...

- **Too many students; too little space... a good problem to have!**
- “Our mission outgrows our walls”
- Current classroom is too small for growing enrolment
- Students lack space to learn effectively
- The demand for training exceeds our facilities
- EMET College desperately needs a larger classroom to accommodate the growing numbers of young people who are dedicating their lives to serve God through ministry



A Larger Classroom for a Larger Calling...


- **This is not just about walls – its about multiplying ministry**
- A classroom with enough capacity with modern facilities will allow EMET to meet enrolment demands
- The facility will:
 - Provide for training and hands-on practice, especially for subjects like hydrotherapy and massage
 - Incorporate a new publication ministry and printing of books
 - Include an in-house dedicated resource library
- EMET is self funded and relies on donations to keep the college open



Designing the Classroom...


Build Specs

- **100% of donations go directly to the project**




Example of Previous Projects

Supporting Refugees...


- Each trip allows the opportunity to make a difference to refugees
